"We did this by removing the tub and creating a beautiful five-foot walk-in shower with a synthetic marble base that is practical and easy to maintain," she said. "Modern glass sliding doors, a rain head shower fixture and recessed niches for shampoo storage added a nice custom touch to this design.

"To balance the colours in the Cambria quartz countertop and glass accent tile, we opted for a neutral warm grey 12"x 24" porcelain tile for the floor and shower walls. For continuity, the accent band in the shower was repeated in the



vanity backsplash, which paired really well with the countertop. We went with a darker stained maple cabinet to highlight the vanity wall

and to contrast the neutral tiles."

Kokivalso tackled the number one issue on Norma's list – too little storage space – by customizing the

vanity area to include two banks of drawers and a linen tower. The results could not have been better appreciated.
