The addition of a larger island than what was originally there introduced an attractive and functional new arrangement for extra workspace and seating.

Like many customers who feel the time is right to invest in a major kitchen overhaul,

the Greely couple took the opportunity to have Westend incorporate modern, highefficiency appliances into their new design. Kokiv ensured they would be pleased by her sensible layout of the new appliances in a space trimmed out with Deslaurier stained maple Northfield cabinets with crown mouldings, Ella Luxury series Cambria quartz countertops with bevelled edgings. Sarana 4x24-inch "wood look" ceramic floor tiles, random-strip Euro glass mosaic backsplash tiles, and a Ladylux Café Pro Dual higharc faucet in a SuperSteel finish from Grohe. Kokiv also created a bar area with a small wine fridge conven-

iently next to the island, and added an appliance garage on top of the bar counter to keep clutter to a minimum.

To improve the efficiency of the countertop work areas and manage the overall kitchen lighting, Kokiv added undercabinet LEDs and dimmable ceiling pot lights. Westend also installed a trio of attractive island pendant lights purchased separately by the customers. The flexibility of the lighting suite gives the homeowners whatever they want in terms of strong work light, or relaxing mood lighting when entertaining.
